Most important things young people learn in different ages:



- No special activities for Beaver or Cup Scouts
- Scouts and Guides in the age of
 - 10-13 years: activities on flat water, swimming, sailing
 - 13-16 years: activities on flowing water, sailing
 - 16-20 years: sailing licence, canoe licene flat water
